Bond of Used Motor Vehicle Dealer,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we

As Principal (hereinafter called Principal), and

of, as Surety (hereafter call Surety), are held and firmly bound unto the State of Alabama in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

The conditions of the foregoing obligation is such that:

WHEREAS, the Principal has been duly appointed a "Used Motor Vehicle Dealer", "Motor Vehicle Reconditioner", "Motor Vehicle Rebuilder," or "Motor Vehicle Wholesaler" as the case may be, under the provisions of Title 40, Chapter 12, Article 8, Code of Alabama 1975, such Principal shall comply with the conditions of any written contract made by such dealer in connection with the sale or exchange of any motor vehicle and shall not violate any of the provisions of Title 40, Chapter 12, Article 8, Code of Alabama 1975, in the conduct of business for which he is licensed.

It is expressly understood and agreed that neither this obligation nor any liability hereunder shall be released or the validity thereof effected by reason of the adoption by the State of Alabama of any Act in lieu of or amendatory to said laws, but this obligation shall continue in full force and effect with respect to said statutes or any amendments thereto or changes therein which may be adopted before the cancellation of this obligation as herein provided, or before the actual cancellation and surrender of this obligation by the State of Alabama pursuant to any law now existing or hereafter adopted relating thereto.

It is further expressly understood and agreed that the liability of both the Principal and the Surety on this bond shall be for the license period of through September 30, and that a new bond or proper continuation certificate must be delivered to the Alabama Commissioner of Revenue AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH LICENSE YEAR, WHICH IS OCTOBER 1, AND EXPIRING ON SEPTEMBER 30 OF THE SAME LICENSE YEAR; provided, however, that the aggregate liability of the Surety in any one license year shall in no event exceed the sum of such bond.

The Surety on this bond may be released and discharged from any and all liability to the State of Alabama accruing on this bond after the expiration of sixty (60) days from the date upon which said Surety shall have filed with the Alabama Department of Revenue written request to be released and discharged provided, however, such request shall not operate to relieve, release or discharge such Surety from any liability already accrued or which shall accrue before the expiration of said sixty (60) day period.

## Bond Form Instructions

If the licensee for which this bond is written is an **individual**, the principal listed on this bond form must reflect the individual as the principal. The d/b/a is used after the name of the individual (i.e.: John Doe, d/b/a Bama County Ford Sales).

If the licensee for which this bond is written is a **partnership**, the principal listed on this bond form must reflect the names of the partners d/b/a the name of the partnership. (All partners must sign the bond.)

If the licensee for which this bond is written is a **corporation**, the principal listed on this bond form must reflect the name of the corporation. The d/b/a is used after the name of the corporation (i.e.: Auto Auctions of Alabama, Inc., d/b/a Bama County Ford Sales).

If the licensee for which this bond is written is a **limited liability company**, the principal listed on this bond form must reflect the names of the partners d/b/a the name of the limited liability company. (All partners must sign the bond.) Example of compound d/b/a: Tom Jones and Sky King, partners d/b/a King Tom, LLC, d/b/a J&K Used Auto Sales.

The bond form must be dated in the appropriate space provided and a power of attorney from the surety company must be attached bearing the same date as the date reflected on the bond form.

The bond form must reflect the name of the surety company, must be signed by the agent of the surety company, and must be signed by the Alabama resident agent.

The bond form must be signed by the principal, the individual, all partners in the event of a partnership (including limited liability companies), or a corporate officer if a corporation.

The telephone number of the Alabama resident agent is needed in the place provided.
