KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, _____, as Principal, and _____, a corporation duly authorized to do surety business in the State of New York, as Surety, are held and firmly bound unto the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles of the State of New York, as Oblige, in the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$20,000.00), for the payment of which well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrator, successors, assigns and our legal representatives, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

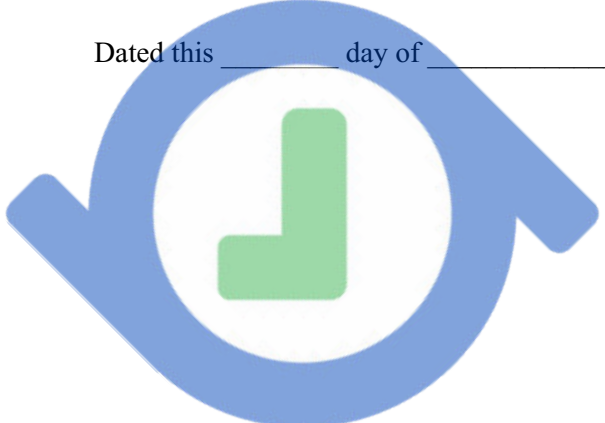
WHEREAS, the said Principal has been granted permission to conduct commercial driver license (CDL) skills tests pursuant to Vehicle and Traffic Law §§ 206, 502(4)(b), and 508(1) and 49 C.F.R. §383.75 and gives this bond pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §383.75(a)(8)(v).

NOW, THEREFORE the condition of this obligation is such, that if the Principal or one or more of its examiners is not involved in fraudulent activities related to conducting skills testing of applicants for a CDL, this bond shall be released by the Commissioner and this obligation shall be void. However, in the event that the Principal or one or more of its examiners is involved in fraudulent activities related to conducting skills testing of applicants for a CDL, the Commissioner shall be entitled to recover against the bond in the amount sufficient to pay for re-testing of applicants.

The Commissioner shall make a written demand upon the Surety for payment, which shall consist of a sworn statement substantiating the amount claimed. Payment of the bond shall not be contingent upon sponsor's approval.

This bond shall remain in full force and effect until released by the Commissioner.
