Any surety who wishes to be relieved from liability arising in this bond shall file with the Commissioner a statement in writing setting forth the desire of the surety to be relieved of liability and the reasons therefor. The surety shall mail a copy of the statement to the last known address of the licensee named in the bond. Twenty (20) days after the required statement is filed with the Commissioner and a copy mailed to the licensee, the surety is released from all liability thereafter arising on the bond.

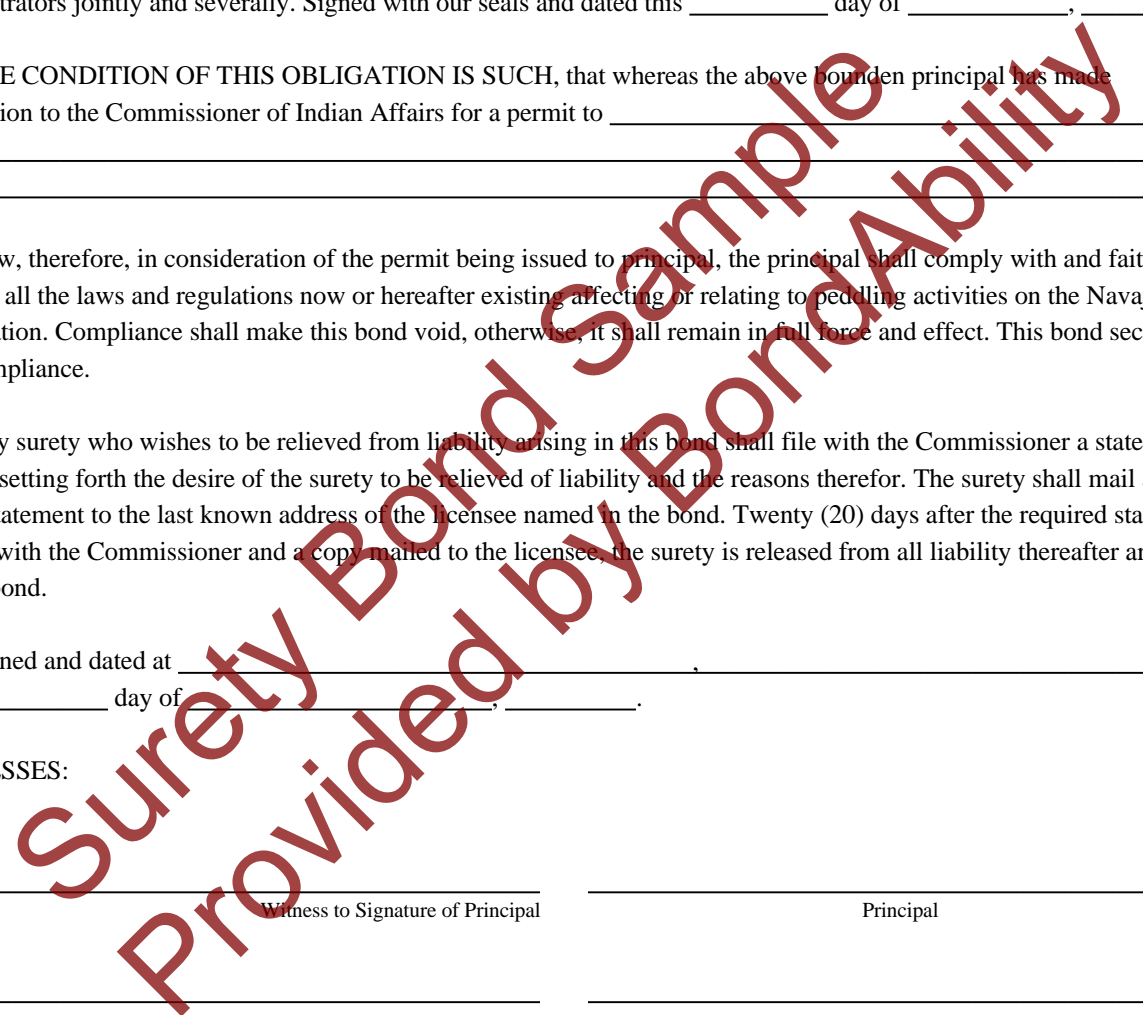
